




The EIB 2022 Municipality Survey covers 744 municipalities in the EU






Over 50% of municipalities find their climate change related investments insufficient




How do you evaluate your investments in the last 3 years in ...?






Larger investment gaps indicated for less developed and transition cohesion regions




How do you evaluate your investments in the last 3 years in ...?






Over 60% of municipalities plan to increase their climate change related investments







Accessing the external finance needed for planned investments is a large constraint




Looking back at the investments you had planned over the last three years, did you receive all of the external finance you sought for the planned investments or only part of it?



Received part of the external finance sought but not all






Access to experts with environmental and technical skills is a major problem

A movement to support the development of beautiful and sustainable places and forms of living together





New European Bauhaus (NEB) territorial development model financial instrument



- A **flexible** financial instrument (FI) model for all stakeholders
- May be a **dedicated** or **part of** a larger financial instrument
- **Combination of Fls and grants** in one operation
- One-stop-shop for final recipients and project promoters

- Based on previous positive experience with **FI** in urban development
- Respect of the three core values of the NEB includes a list of **guiding questions** to assess alignment
- a new crosscutting policy objective: 'Policy Objective 5 - Europe closer to citizens'
- other policy and specific objectives to support actions for integrated sustainable territorial development

Guiding questions – 'Sustainability'

a non-exhaustive list

Is sustainability built into the project concept?

Does the project address the climate mitigation and adaptation, for example in construction of new buildings or old buildings?

Does the project present innovative solutions for sustainability, for example, a new process, new material or technology?

Does the project promote revitalising existing urban spaces by reusing exiting but empty buildings?

Does the project include measures to reduce energy use in renovated buildings?



What is meant by 'Aesthetics'? Quality of experience and style beyond functionality



Architectural style

Guiding questions – 'Aesthetics'

a non-exhaustive list

Is aesthetics built into the project concept?

Is the approach of a high quality – connected to the cultural context of the project?

Does it strengthen the project and help enhance the 'sense of place'?

Does the project integrate with the existing landscape?

Does the project enhance the quality of experience – through art or other visual, sensory or other approaches?



Guiding questions – 'Inclusion' *a non-exhaustive list*


Does the project demonstrate a good understanding of inclusion?

Does the project bring communities closer together and address specific needs of various groups, including vulnerable ones through reconstruction and renovation of built environment?

Does the project apply the 'design for all' principle in the redesign of the built environment to remove barriers for access?

Does the project ensure positive intergenerational exchange and community building ensuring affordability and accessibility?





One stop shop for NEB projects











A one stop shop approach promotes:

- Ease of use by final recipients;
- Combination of financial instruments and grants in a coordinated manner;
- More **efficiency and economies of scale**;
- Increased pooling of funds and a better coordination among stakeholders;
- An **integrated design and screening of projects** for the financial instruments and grant components to enhance the coherence of the support;
- Capacity of MS, local and regional financial intermediaries, urban/rural municipalities







New European Bauhaus model FI - an opportunity for urban development funds


The potential impact of the New European Bauhaus for urban development through FI:

- Alignment with integrated sustainable urban development
- Stimulate demand boost pipeline of projects in categories:
 - = Reconnecting with nature
 - = Regaining a sense of belonging
 - = Prioritising the places and people that need it the most
 - = The need for long-term, life-cycle thinking in the industrial ecosystem
- Suitable for large and small municipalities, smaller community projects as well as larger more formal technical projects
- Combination of FI with grants
- Urban development funds gaining and applying local expertise upstream downstream work




Ancoats: 19th Century Industrial Powerhouse


- World's first industrial suburb

- Established Manchester as "Cottonopolis" and leading industrial city in 19th century

















Municipal Entrepreneurism

Manchester Life – Joint Venture between City Council & Abu Dhabi United Group

- Residential Development Sites stalled early 2010's as a result of "Credit Crunch"
- City Council established JV with Abu Dhabi United Group (ADUG)
- MCC Land, ADUG Development Finance
- £63m Build to Rent Loan from UK Government (fully repaid)
- Phase 1 = 1,500 new homes 2015 2022
- All Homes are for Open Market Sale or for Market Rent

Part of Pan-European Corridor VIII of TEN-T network












The first Positive Emission District

- Achieve climate neutral urban zones through holistic integrated measures








