
# JESSICA in Europe and Poland



## JESSICA in EUROPE


- 16 JESSICA HF's (1 wound-up) currently operating in 8 Member States
- 39 agreements signed with UDFs for the amount of EUR 1.6 bn
- Over 1500 agreements with Final Beneficiaries\*

## JESSICA in POLAND

- 4 JESSICA HF's (1 wound-up) implemented in 4 regions (in total in 5 regions in the whole period 2007-13)
- 5 UDFs (7 UDFs)
- 159 Investment Agreements amounting to PLN 1.2 bn

## Revitalization of the Sopot Railway station

### Scope of the project:

Widely understood **revitalization of the railway station in Sopot and its adjacent area**

**JESSICA loan: PLN 41.9 mln**

### Key social goals of the project:

- **creating** new large **square** to replace neglected railway buildings, which will enable **organization of cultural events**
- **creating** an **aesthetic, friendly** and **safer zone** (monitoring)
- **increasing standard of living**
- **improving access** for travellers and tourists to **Internet** (WI-FI network) and **innovative Web services**
- **creating new jobs**
- **improving facilities** for **disabled people**

## Water treatment plant modernisation in Leszno

### Scope of the project:

Creation of a new, attractive urban space, in order to provide the **environmental education centre** and to **enable the upgrade of water treatment process**

**JESSICA loan: PLN 7.4 mln**

### Key social goals of the project:

- **Creating new ecological education opportunities** (support of an environmental education at local schools)
- **Reinforcing environmental protection** (eco-friendly technologies: heat pump, intelligent automatics, LED lighting)
- **Providing high quality drinking water**

## Revitalisation of Combine Harvester Factory in Płock - stage VII

### Scope of the project:

The revitalisation process will take place in a **post-industrial area** and will include:

- **adaptation and reconstruction of buildings and infrastructure**
- **refurbishment** of the adjacent area
- **purchase of a set of machines** aimed at creating a modern, integrated and innovative production-logistics center

The area and the buildings situated therein are to be used by the **company** for the **production of innovative roof tiles**.

**JESSICA loan: PLN 15 mln**

### Key social goals of the project:

- **Reducing energy and materials** consumption
- Equipping revitalized facilities with **modern technical infrastructure** and **social networking facilities**
- **Preventing** old buildings and industrial infrastructure **from complete degradation**
- Using revitalized buildings and structures **for modern and innovative processes** and **services**
- Creating **new permanent jobs**
